We the undersigned do hereby certify that on the seventh day of October A.D. 1843 at a meeting duly notified and held according to law at the school house in the village of Batticruk it was Resolved that this Society be known as the Batticruk Baptist Society

Deacon William Bettley & Charles Cooley were elected to receive the votes of the members of said Society, proceeded to ballot for trustees to manage the concerns of said Society, and on counting the votes so aforesaid we do further certify,

Nidabiah Angell, Zachus K. Joby, Edward Parker, Thonard Starkweather & Charles Cooley was duly elected trustees to manage the concerns of said Society
